Our family of existing Members and senior Members represents a diverse collection of capabilities and a unique opportunity for networking social welfare and project activities. Hence, we like to extend to you an invitation to stay engaged with our District 301.

This Newsletter will feature updates about project activities (both previous and future), new partnerships with PHD Rural Development Foundation & Family Welfare Foundation, and success stories from Members of District 301. District events like District Assembly "Aamantran" where more than 350 Members attended is a landmark feat in the history of District 301 and District Teej/ Raas-Leela, an event where 7 District Chairmen along with co-ordinators from other Districts attended the event and made it a grand success. In addition, large numbers of Inner Wheel Members of District 301 were also present. A North Zone Seminar Synergy (2+2=5) hosted by District 301. Stree Shakti Women Empowerment wherein eminent speakers like Hon'ble Justice of Delhi High Court, Women Entrepreneurs, Additional Solicitor General etc., were invited. District Seminar 'Synergy' was organized to show our true strength – what, we the Members of Inner Wheel are capable of doing; to show our real strength; to show our unity and integrity. Because we in Inner Wheel believes in "Together We Can Do Much, Alone We Can Do Nothing".

Other than the special projects, District 301 has been engaged in diversified projects, viz., Anti Drugs & Aids Awareness, Anti Child Labour, Blood Donation, Environment Protection, Eye Relief & Cornea Donation, Polio Eradication, Senior Citizens Welfare, Women Development Committee, Upliftment of Girl Child and many more. A special project on Basic Life Support Training Program was organized in collaboration with Fortis Hospital. A special project on Mass Marriage was held wherein 56 couples were married in a day.

Under the guidance of District Chairman, IWC Delhi Midtown organized 'JAIPUR FOOT' project for the 250 physically handicapped where artificial limbs, crutches, calipers and tricycles were provided free of cost.

With the initiative of the Chairman, a unique and one of its kind projects – 'Support A Child Create A Future' - was carried out with a big bang. 607 Educational School Kits comprising of stationery, pencil box, tiffin box and water bottle in a school bag were distributed among the students of Balwantray Mehta Vidya Bhawan.

We have especially designed the Newsletter also as a platform for you to share updates about your District and share your invaluable views with us.

The interactions between District 301 and its extended family of Seniors and Friends will certainly go a long way to make our District a vibrant Organization that can provide the best possible social welfare activities by way of our projects and with sheer hardwork, dedication and work experience.

jute and cloth bags were distributed.

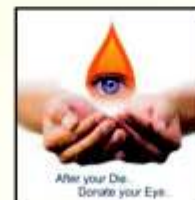

Polio Summit 2012



Rotary District 3010 and IW District 301 were one of the main organizer and participant in the Polio Summit, which was organized by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India in joint collaboration with Rotary International. Certain guidelines were provided in the Summit which declared that sooner India will be Polio Free. The Summit also highlighted the work done hand-in-hand by Rotary District 3010 and Inner Wheel District 301 in making India Polio Free.
