Margaret Owen, later Mrs. Oliver Golding the wife of a Manchester Rotarian, was born of Welsh parentage at Hey-Brecon. She was trained as a nurse and had served during the First World War. This triggered off a deep desire to help all ailing, deprived humanity. She was an extremely capable business woman and a great philanthropist; her chief social interest being the Manchester Girls' Orphanage & Ancoats Hospital, for which the Inner Wheel of Manchester provided and furnished a mortuary chapel. She also did a great deal for the Girl Guide Movement, in which she held the Office of Commissioner.

She formed, directly and personally, numerous Clubs and several Districts and her inspiration is remembered to this day, she successfully achieved even harder task in persuading Members to look beyond their local concerns and become part of a greater whole and serve the Society.

Here was a vital personality combined with a clear brain and the ability to convey ideals to others. She was an excellent speaker and had a lively sense of humour which enriched her words. Nature had bestowed her with gift of inspiring friendship and devotion. Her greatest attribute was courage and courage was what Inner Wheel needed in the beginning. Inner Wheel was firmly established during her lifetime upon the path which it was to follow thereafter.

I was born in Scotland and went to New Zealand with my parent and my brother when I was 9 years old. I have lived in the same area of the Bay of Plenty (in the North Island) most of the time since then. The Opotiki area has a total population (town and surrounding area) of only 10,000. I live within sight of the Pacific Ocean and we enjoy a moderate climate – not too hot and not too cold. At times, we have lots of small earthquakes.

Soon after we arrived in New Zealand we moved to a very isolated area where my father was helping to build a road through a scenic gorge. I attended a very small country school for about 10 months. I was the only white student in the school and things that I learned is that time were to stand me in good stead in my teaching career, and in my adult life.

When we moved closer to town, Ken Youg was in my class right through my Opotiki school days (from about the age of 10 years).

I attended Teacher's College for two years and I came back to Opotiki to teach music, remedial maths, and commerce practice. Ken and I both enjoy our music – I often used to say that although I was the music teacher, he was the better musician.

Ken and I marked at the end of that school year and I became a farmer's wife. It was no easy task for someone who knew nothing of a farm life. Almost immediately we had two farm workers living with us. It was a steep learning curve for me.

Ken and I still live and work on our organic dairy farm and kiwi fruit orchard.

Our three children were born in quick succession. When our youngest child was one year old, our home burned down and we were left with a freezer, a car, and the clothes that we stood in. I will never forget the generosity of people in our area. We learned that you cannot pay back such kindness, you can only pass it on to someone else. This was perhaps the start of what would influence my future Inner Wheel life.

Ken had joined Jaycees and when he retired from that, he was invited to join Rotary. I went to a ladies night and although I could name all the ladies present, I felt that I did not know any of them so I thought I had better join Inner Wheel. I joined Inner Wheel on 19<sup>th</sup> November 1986 and the following March was “elected” to become Club Secretary in the July. Since that time there has not been any time when I have not been on an Inner Wheel committee at some level. Quite obviously, I thoroughly enjoy it and have made marvelous friends all round the country and internationally.

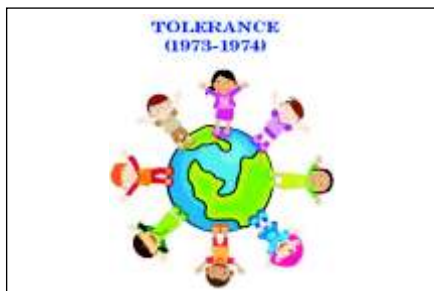
I have learned much about the passion and energy of Inner Wheel members throughout the world, working in many avenues of life to uphold the principles of Inner Wheel. I am proud to be part of this organisation. We have been described in the past as an international organisation whose members are vibrant, forward looking women who give service to their communities locally, nationally and internationally. I believe this description is still accurate.

I was appointed a Justice of the Peace in 1995 and the following year became a Marriage and Funeral Celebrant. I am a Past President of the Justice of the Peace Association for our area, and regularly preside in the Criminal Court in my home town and in a neighbouring town (holding a position very similar to that of Magistrate).

In 2011, I was presented with a Queen's Service Medal in recognition of work done in the community.

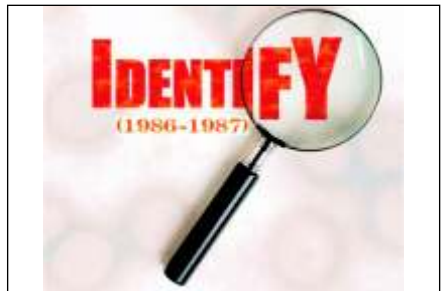

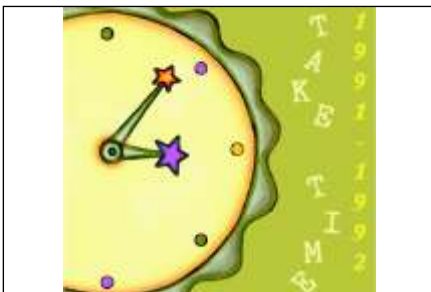
